- LCME occurs every 8 years and is primarily for quality improvement; representatives from AMA & AAMC
- 12 LCME standards that we need to fulfill
- Timeline
 - o Fall 2022: assimilating data and task forces for quality improvement
 - Visit: February 18th 21st, 2024
 - (rest of timeline can be shared if interested)
- Opportunities for student involvement (will reach out later this fall to begin recruiting volunteers) → LCME want to hear from students also not in leadership/MSG
 - LCME Task force and self-study subcommittees
 - LCME Launch party volunteers
 - Redcap student responses (surveys need ~90% participation)
 - Tours of school + various meetings
- Mock site visit → students will be able to participate
 - Will resurvey students afterwards
- Focus is really to highlight the positives and unique qualities of the school
- LCME accreditation webpage on medical school website
- Currently working on: (Everything is approved by curriculum council)
 - Updating policy documents
 - Implementing standardized expectations between each course (reflected in updated syllabi)
 - Rewriting clerkship objectives
 - Planning on updating e-curriculum (roll out planned for about 1 year from now)
 - Working on implementing feedback for courses (POPH, incorporating more data interpretation)
 - Improving testing software (Examsoft started for M1/M2 in Fall 2022)
 - Responding to feedback about M4 year starting late (stress with residency applications) → rolled back the calendar to address this (M3 have shortened clerkships and M2 have shorter break after step 1)
 - M3 focus groups convened to create tool for reporting and tracking mistreatment during clerkships (located on med school site)
 - Recognition of exemplars
- Need 2 representatives from MSG to serve on self-study committee
- Need feedback about survey fatigue → meaningful incentives for student classes
